6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
8 requiring continuous work schedule for certain
9 construction projects; stating exceptions;
10 authorizing entities to promulgate rules; providing
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1101.1 of Title 69, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma
17 Turnpike Authority shall require bids for construction projects with
18 an estimated duration of thirty (30) days or longer to be based upon
19 a work schedule of twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days
20 per week that shall also require the days to run consecutively,
21 except as provided by subsection B of this section, until the
22 project is completed. This requirement shall be in addition to any
23 other requirements for contract bidding otherwise authorized by law
24 or rule.

1 B. The Department and the Authority shall not penalize
2 contractors unable to execute a work schedule of twenty-four (24)
3 hours per day, seven (7) days per week due to holidays or hazardous
4 working conditions.

5 C. The Department and the Authority shall promulgate rules to
6 implement the provisions of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2009.

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
