8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Grand River Dam Authority;  
10 amending Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L. 2007 (82 O.S.  
11 Supp. 2007, Section 863.3), which relates to the  
12 Joint Legislative Task Force on the Grand River Dam  
13 Authority; modifying name; and declaring an  
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L.  
17 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 863.3), is amended to read as  
18 follows:

19 Section 863.3 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative  
20 ~~Task Force~~ Advisory Committee on the Grand River Dam Authority for  
21 the purpose of studying the functions, activities, policies,  
22 procedures and expenditures performed by the district and any  
23 related issues the task force deems appropriate. Members of the  
24 task force shall be appointed in January of each year following a  
state general election by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate

1 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Membership shall  
2 be made up of all Senate and House members whose legislative  
3 districts include a portion of the Grand River Dam Authority  
4 district. The President Pro Tempore and Speaker shall each  
5 designate one of their members to be cochair of the task force.  
6 Meetings of the task force shall be called by the cochair. A  
7 majority of the appointed members shall constitute a quorum for any  
8 meeting of the task force. Staffing assistance shall be provided by  
9 the staff of the Senate and House of Representatives.

10 B. The members of the task force created herein shall continue  
11 to serve until new members are appointed pursuant to the provisions  
12 of subsection A of this section. Such task force is authorized to  
13 adopt any recommendations or issue any report it deems necessary.  
14 Any recommendations or reports shall be approved by a majority of  
15 the appointed members. Copies of any recommendations or reports  
16 issued by the task force shall be distributed to the Governor, the  
17 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
18 Representatives, the members of the Grand River Dam Authority Board  
19 of Directors and the General Manager of the Grand River Dam  
20 Authority.

21 C. Members serving on this task force shall be entitled to  
22 travel reimbursement as provided by Section 456 of Title 74 of the  
23 Oklahoma Statutes.

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1       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
