7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2001, Section 1132.1, which relates to license and
9 registration fees; removing certain obsolete
10 language; removing certain limitation on deposit of
11 monies to certain fund; and providing an effective
12 date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1132.1, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1132.1 A. There is levied and there shall be paid to
17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) upon
18 every vehicle to be registered or licensed, except for those
19 licensed pursuant to subsection (c) of Section 1210.34 of Title 70
20 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Said fee shall accrue and shall be
21 collectible upon each vehicle under the same circumstances and shall
22 be payable in the same manner and times as apply to vehicle licenses
23 and registrations under the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle
24 License and Registration Act; provided, said fee shall be paid in

1 full for the then current year at the time any vehicle is first
2 registered in a calendar year.

3 B. Two-thirds of the monies collected pursuant to this section
4 shall be transferred by the Tax Commission each month to the State
5 Treasurer for deposit in the General Revenue Fund. ~~For the fiscal~~
6 ~~year beginning July 1, 1999, of the remaining one third of the~~
7 ~~monies collected pursuant to this section each fiscal year, the~~
8 ~~first Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) shall be~~
9 ~~transferred by the Tax Commission to the State Treasurer for deposit~~
10 ~~in the Motor Vehicle Driver Education Revolving Fund created in~~
11 ~~Section 2 of this act and any amount in excess of Four Hundred~~
12 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) shall be transferred by the Tax~~
13 ~~Commission to the State Treasurer for deposit in the General Revenue~~
14 ~~Fund.~~ For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and for each
15 fiscal year thereafter, ~~of~~ the remaining one-third of the monies
16 collected pursuant to this section each fiscal year, ~~the first Nine~~
17 ~~Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000.00) shall be transferred by the~~
18 Tax Commission to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Motor
19 Vehicle Driver Education Revolving Fund created in Section ~~2~~ 1132.2
20 of this act ~~and any amount in excess of Nine Hundred Thousand~~
21 ~~Dollars (\$900,000.00) shall be transferred by the Tax Commission to~~
22 ~~the State Treasurer for deposit in the General Revenue Fund~~ title.

23 C. The collection and payment of said fee shall be a
24 prerequisite to license or registration of any vehicle, except for

1 those licensed pursuant to subsection (c) of Section 1210.34 of
2 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
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
