6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; providing waiver
8 of resident tuition for students meeting certain
9 requirements; specifying certain time limit;
10 providing for codification; providing an effective
11 date; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, no
17 resident tuition shall be charged to students who graduate from a
18 high school in this state with a cumulative grade point average of
19 at least 3.0 and are children of employees of a public school
20 district in this state.

21 B. Such waiver of resident tuition shall be limited to a period
22 of five (5) years.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
