6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to health care; creating the Person-
8 Centered Medical Home Task Force within the Insurance
9 Department; providing purpose of task force;
10 directing the Insurance Commissioner to determine
11 certain duties and make appointments; requiring
12 certain report; providing for noncodification; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created until November 30, 2009, the Person-
18 Centered Medical Home Task Force within the Insurance Department.
19 The purpose of the task force shall be to study the quality, safety,
20 value and effectiveness of the patient-centered medical home
21 concept.

22 B. The Insurance Commissioner shall determine, in coordination
23 with an association of primary care physicians in this state, the
24 duties and operations of the task force, including, but not limited
to, the appointment of task force members, number, frequency and

1 | locations of meetings, and procedures for developing findings and
2 | recommendations.

3 | C. The task force shall report its findings, including any
4 | legislative recommendations, to the Governor, the President Pro
5 | Tempore and Co-President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker
6 | of the House of Representatives by November 30, 2009.

7 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
