7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; defining term;
8 requiring certain detection of motorcycles; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-209 of Title 47, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. As used in this section, the term "traffic-actuated electric
16 traffic-control signal" means an electrically operated traffic-
17 control signal, installed and operating at an intersection, for
18 which the signal intervals vary according to the demands of
19 vehicular traffic as registered by a detector.

20 B. In addition to any other type of vehicle, the presence of
21 which may be registered by the detector for a traffic-actuated
22 electric traffic-control signal, a detector for a traffic-actuated
23 electric traffic-control signal shall be capable of registering the
24 presence of a motorcycle.
