5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001,  
7 Section 57, which relates to enforcement; making  
8 language gender neutral; and providing an effective  
9 date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 57, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 57. It shall be the duty of the Administrator and/or  
15 Director to enforce the provisions of this act. When informed of  
16 any violation thereof it shall be his duty to investigate same, and  
17 he or she may institute criminal proceedings for enforcement of this  
18 act, or apply to any court of competent jurisdiction and/or the  
19 Attorney General in order to seek injunctive relief on behalf of the  
20 State of Oklahoma. In order to make more effective the foregoing  
21 statutory provisions and rules and regulations, the Administrator is  
22 hereby authorized to prepare and promulgate such rules and  
23 regulations as may from time to time be deemed necessary, not  
24 inconsistent with the provisions of this act. A violation of such

1 rules and regulations shall be deemed to be a violation of this act,  
2 and any person convicted of violating the provisions of this act  
3 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than  
4 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00),  
5 or the fee charged for the service, whichever is greater, for each  
6 offense, or be imprisoned in the county jail for a period of not  
7 exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment, at the  
8 discretion of the court.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
