6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; providing tuition waiver
8 for certain students to certain institutions of
9 higher education and technology center schools;
10 specifying certain limitations for waiver; providing
11 for codification; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. No resident tuition shall be charged by institutions within
18 The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or by any technology
19 center school district to students who are awarded the General
20 Educational Development (GED) State Diploma by the State Board of
21 Education.

22 B. The waiver of resident tuition shall be limited to:

- 23 1. Individuals who are at least eighteen (18) years of age;
24 2. Individuals who have been accepted for admission to an
institution of higher education or technology center school;

1 3. The first one thousand (1,000) students who enroll each
2 academic year; and

3 4. A period of one (1) year for each student.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
