6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
8 designating memorial roads and bridges; requiring
9 placemen of markers; providing for codification; and
10 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall
17 be designated the "Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S.
18 Army 3rd Infantry Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of
19 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
20 upon the bridge bearing that name.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton
2 shall be designated the "Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of
3 the Oklahoma House of Representatives Memorial Highway". The
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
5 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
