6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to insurance; requiring health
8 benefit plans to cover certain preventative health
9 care services; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.20 of Title 36, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any health benefit plan, including the State and Education
16 Employees Group Health Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or
17 renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2009, shall provide
18 coverage for benefits provided for preventative health care services
19 including physicals and testing regardless of whether the provider
20 is considered in network for any insurance company. The coverage
21 provided by this section shall be equal to one hundred percent
22 (100%) of the contracted allowable, when applicable, or up to, but
23 not more than Medicare allowable for each service when no contract
24 applies. Each laboratory test shall be paid for unless that test is

1 usually included in a "disease-oriented panel" or profile as defined
2 by Federal Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Codes. All
3 laboratory testing shall be paid for when done by an Oklahoma
4 laboratory with Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA)
5 certification. The benefit period deductible shall not apply.
6 Covered services are subject to physician's office co-pay only if
7 services are provided in a healthcare facility.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
