6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to poor persons; amending 56 O.S.
8 2001, Section 231, which relates to aid for dependent
9 children; updating language; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2001, Section 231, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 231. Any person who shall make application for aid for
15 dependent children with the Department of ~~Public Welfare~~ Human
16 Services, or any of its county offices or other subagencies, must,
17 in order to be eligible for further assistance payments, where the
18 person or persons legally responsible for such support is willfully
19 and without lawful excuse failing to furnish necessary food,
20 clothing, shelter or medical attendance for such child or children,
21 within three (3) months from the day of application request the
22 district attorney of the county where such applicant resides to file
23 criminal charges against the person or persons legally responsible
24 for the support of such child or children, and cooperate fully in

1 prosecuting such charges to completion when filed by the district
2 attorney.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
