6 An Act relating to torts; providing immunity from
7 liability for person making certain report; stating
8 exception; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7.1 of Title 76, unless there is
13 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any person who in good faith and exercising due care in making a
15 report of allegedly suspicious behavior of another person or persons
16 to a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or agency or
17 other security personnel shall have immunity from any civil or
18 criminal liability that might otherwise be incurred or imposed.
19 This section shall not apply to any person who willfully or
20 recklessly makes a false report to a federal, state or local law
21 enforcement officer or agency or other security personnel.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
