6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishment; making  
8 disturbance by loud or unusual or obscene music or  
9 certain other noise a crime; stating parameters;  
providing penalty; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1362 of Title 21, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or  
17 maliciously cause to be emitted from any vehicle any loud, unusual  
18 or obscene music or other continuous noise which harasses another  
19 person and can be heard from a distance of fifty (50) feet or more  
20 whether the vehicle emitting such music or noise has its windows  
21 open or closed.

22 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of  
23 subsection A of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor  
24 punishable by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred and Fifty

1 Dollars (\$350.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period  
2 of not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and  
3 imprisonment.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
