7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 7308-1.8, which relates to the Juvenile Sex
9 Offender Registration Act; clarifying language; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7308-1.8, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 7308-1.8. A. A juvenile sex offender who fails to
16 register or provide notification of a change of name or address is
17 guilty of a misdemeanor.

18 B. A parent or guardian who has custody and control of a
19 juvenile sex offender commits a misdemeanor offense of failure to
20 supervise a child if the juvenile offender fails to register or
21 provide notification of a change of name or address as required by
22 ~~this act~~ the Juvenile Sex Offender Registration Act. A person
23 convicted of this offense is punishable by a fine of not more than
24 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
