8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to higher education; authorizing
10 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to adopt
policy providing for resident tuition for certain
11 students; providing for codification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3226.1 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may adopt a
19 policy which allows a student to enroll in an institution within The
20 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and be eligible for
21 resident tuition if the student:

22 1. Satisfies admission standards as determined by the Oklahoma
23 State Regents for Higher Education for the appropriate type of

1 institution and has secured admission to, and enrolled in, an
2 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;

3 2. Has a grandparent that is a resident of this state and the
4 grandparent has filed a tax return with the Oklahoma Tax Commission
5 for the fifteen (15) years prior to the student's application; and

6 3. Is a United States citizen.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
