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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2001, Section 6-122, as amended by Section 11,
9 Chapter 392, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section
10 6-122), which relates to driver license renewal by
11 mail; directing the Department of Public Safety to
12 develop a website for online renewal of certain
13 documents; establishing certain limitations for
14 online renewal; requiring certain method of payment
15 for certain fees; requiring payment of certain fees
16 to motors license agents; directing the Department to
17 promulgate certain rules; directing the Oklahoma Tax
18 Commission to develop a website for online renewal of
19 certain registrations; directing the Commission to
20 promulgate certain rules; requiring payment of
21 certain fees to motor license agents; providing for
22 limitation of online renewal requests; providing for
23 codification; and providing an effective date.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-122, as
amended by Section 11, Chapter 392, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007,
Section 6-122), is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-122. A. The Department of Public Safety shall
develop procedures whereby driver licenses issued under the
provisions of Section 6-101 et seq. of this title may be renewed by

1 mail except for licenses to be renewed by aliens as prescribed by
2 subsection D of Section 6-115 of this title. Any license issued
3 pursuant to this section shall be valid for a period of not more
4 than four (4) years.

5 B. Subject to the availability of designated funds, the
6 Department shall develop a website for the online renewal of Class D
7 driver licenses and identification cards issued under the provisions
8 of Sections 6-101 et seq. of this title. Renewal of a Class D
9 driver license or identification card through a procedure created
10 under this subsection shall be subject to the following limitations:

11 1. Only unexpired and unrestricted Class D driver licenses and
12 identification cards which were issued, renewed, or replaced on or
13 after July 1, 2004, shall be eligible for online renewal;

14 2. A driver license or identification card eligible for online
15 renewal pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection shall not be
16 renewed online more than one time in succession. An eligible driver
17 license or identification card may be renewed online if the most
18 recent issuance, renewal, or replacement of such driver license or
19 identification card was accomplished by the personal appearance of
20 the licensee or cardholder before a motor license agent or the
21 Department. After the online renewal of an eligible driver license
22 or identification card, the subsequent renewal of such license or
23 card shall be accomplished by the personal appearance of the

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1 licensee or cardholder before a motor license agent or the
2 Department; and

3 3. Driver licenses or identification cards to be renewed by
4 aliens as prescribed by subsection D of Section 6-115 of this title
5 shall not be eligible for online renewal.

6 Payment of any required fees for the renewal of a driver license or
7 identification card pursuant to the provisions of this subsection
8 shall be made by a nationally recognized credit or debit card issued
9 to the applicant for renewal. The Department shall pay monthly to
10 all motor license agents such fees retainable by motor license
11 agents for driver license renewals pursuant to Section 1141.1 of
12 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pro rata of each motor license
13 agent's average monthly volume of Class D driver license renewals
14 for the twelve (12) months prior to the effective date of this act.
15 The Department shall promulgate rules and develop procedures to
16 implement the provisions of this subsection.

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1113.1 of Title 47, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Subject to the availability of designated funds and the operability
21 of the online verification system for motor vehicle insurance
22 described by Section 7-600.2 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
23 the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall develop a website for the online
24 acceptance and processing of renewal requests for registrations

1 authorized by Sections 1101 et seq. of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes and by Sections 4001 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes. The Commission shall promulgate rules and procedures to
4 implement the provisions of this section, which shall include, but
5 not be limited to, procedures for obtaining security verification
6 information through the online verification system for motor vehicle
7 insurance described in Section 7-600.2 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes, and procedures for accepting credit card or debit card
9 payments for associated fees and charges. From such fees and
10 charges, the Commission shall pay monthly to all motor license
11 agents such fees retainable by motor license agents for
12 registrations pursuant to Section 1141.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
13 Statutes, pro rata of each motor license agent's average monthly
14 volume of registrations for the twelve (12) months prior to the
15 effective date of this act. The Commission shall not be required to
16 accept online renewal requests for any such registration if the
17 application is required by law to be accompanied by any affidavit or
18 is subject to special conditions or eligibility criteria prior to
19 renewal.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.

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
