6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to courts; requiring certain
8 appointment for specified actions; providing for
9 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 95.10 of Title 20, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 In the event a civil action brought in a district court is
16 appealed and is subsequently reversed and remanded, in whole or in
17 part, by final order of an appellate court of this state, the Chief
18 Justice of the Supreme Court shall appoint a district or associate
19 district judge from a different county to preside over all
20 proceedings in such action on remand to the district court.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
