5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to contracts; amending 15 O.S. 2001,
7 Section 451, which relates to notice upon wrongful
8 detention; making certain language gender neutral;
9 and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 15 O.S. 2001, Section 451, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 451. A bailee who believes that a thing deposited with
14 him or her is wrongfully detained from its true owner may give him
15 or her notice of the bailment; and if, within a reasonable time
16 afterwards, he or she does not claim it, and sufficiently establish
17 his or her right thereto, and indemnify the bailee against the claim
18 of the bailor, the bailee is exonerated from liability to the person
19 to whom he or she gave the notice, upon returning the thing to the
20 bailor, or assuming, in good faith, a new obligation changing his or
21 her position in respect to the thing, to his or her prejudice.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
