5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to common carriers; amending 13 O.S.  
7 2001, Section 176.6, which relates to use of  
8 intercepted communications; clarifying statutory  
reference; and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 13 O.S. 2001, Section 176.6, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 176.6 Whenever any wire, oral or electronic  
14 communication has been intercepted, no part of the contents of such  
15 communication and no evidence derived therefrom may be received in  
16 evidence in any trial, hearing or other proceeding in or before any  
17 court, grand jury, department, officer, agency, regulatory body,  
18 legislative committee or other authority of the state, or a  
19 political subdivision thereof, if the disclosure of that information  
20 would be in violation of the Security of Communications Act, Section  
21 176.1 et seq. of this title.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
