8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Concurrent Resolution organizing certain
10 governmental entities to fund environmental impact
11 study on West Outer Loop road project; providing for
12 commencement of study; directing certain state
13 entities to participate; and directing distribution.

14 WHEREAS, after many years of discussing various proposals
15 designing a major road project, known as the West Outer Loop, to
16 alleviate traffic congestion and enhance economic development
17 opportunities on the west side of the Oklahoma City metropolitan
18 area; and

19 WHEREAS, the following governmental entities are interested
20 parties to the discussions involved in locating funding sources and
21 shall make up a partnership arrangement consisting of the Oklahoma
22 Turnpike Authority, the Department of Transportation, Oklahoma
23 County, Canadian County, the City of Oklahoma City, the City of
24 Mustang, the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments, and any

1 other interested municipalities or other public entities located
2 near or within the proposed construction area.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
4 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 THAT the partnership of above-named governmental entities shall
7 be organized under the direction of the City of Oklahoma City and
8 shall determine specific funding necessary to implement an
9 environmental impact study on the area from the western terminus of
10 the Kilpatrick Turnpike to meet Airport Road in Oklahoma City.

11 THAT the environmental impact study shall be commenced within
12 six months of the time dedicated funding in the amount necessary to
13 complete the study has been determined by the partnership.

14 THAT the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority and the Oklahoma Department
15 of Transportation are hereby directed to participate in the
16 activities of the partnership and may contribute funding for the
17 project as otherwise authorized by law.

18 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,
19 the Secretary of Transportation, the Director of the Oklahoma
20 Department of Transportation, Oklahoma County, the City of Oklahoma
21 City, the City of Mustang, and the Association of Central Oklahoma
22 Governments.
