6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
8 to refer to the people for their approval or  
9 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 4 of  
10 Article III of the Constitution of the State of  
11 Oklahoma; providing ballot title; and directing  
12 filing.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
17 the following proposed amendment to Section 4 of Article III of the  
18 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

19 Section 4. The Legislature shall prescribe the time and manner  
20 of holding and conducting all elections, and enact such laws as may  
21 be necessary to detect and punish fraud in such elections. All  
22 voting systems in this state shall be paper-based unless otherwise  
23 prescribed by federal law. The Legislature may provide by law for  
24 the registration of electors throughout the state and, when it is so

1 provided, no person shall vote at any election unless ~~he~~ the person  
2 shall have registered according to law.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
5 the following form:

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure amends Section 4 of Article 3 of the State  
10 Constitution. This measure would require all voting systems in  
11 this state to be paper-based. This measure would require the  
12 state to comply with federal law to accommodate disabled voters.

13 SHALL THIS AMENDMENT BE APPROVED BY THE PEOPLE?

16 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,  
17 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file  
18 one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2  
19 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney  
20 General.
