7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution congratulating the Red Oak Lady Eagles
9 Fastpitch Softball team for winning the State Class B
10 Championship; commending their victories; and
11 directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Red Oak High School in Latimer County has approximately
13 80 students and a combined staff and faculty of 11; and

14 WHEREAS, the Red Oak Lady Eagles Fastpitch Softball team ended
15 their 2006 season with 38 wins against 5 losses, claimed the Rock
16 Island Conference Championship, the Panama Tournament Championship,
17 and the Hartshorne Tournament Championship, and was the Preston
18 Tournament Championship Runner-up; and

19 WHEREAS, in the 2006 State Tournament the Lady Eagles scored 30
20 runs in 3 games while only giving up 3 runs. The Lady Eagles won
21 the quarterfinal game 12 to 1 over Forgan; the semifinal game 6 to 0
22 over Moss; and the championship game 12 to 2 over Arapaho; and

23 WHEREAS, individuals receiving honors were Jocey Leedom, who was
24 All-State, All-Region, and Rock Island All-Conference; Alicia Rider,

1 who was Rock Island All-Conference; Cayce Coleman, who was Rock
2 Island All-Conference; and Javen Henson, who was also Rock Island
3 All-Conference.
