7 A Resolution congratulating the Sequoyah High School
8 Eagles football team for winning the 2006 Class 3A
9 State championship; commending the team for winning
the school's first state football championship; and
directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the 2006 Class 3A State championship finals football
13 game between Sequoyah and Marlow, held in Wantland Stadium at the
14 University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond, Oklahoma, was delayed
15 until a Monday night because of inclement weather; and

16 WHEREAS, after the delay, although the stadium was surrounded by
17 snow, the playing field had been cleared. Many fans drove 126 miles
18 from Claremore, Oklahoma, to support their Eagles, and both schools
19 brought their bands. The Sequoyah-Claremore High School Eagles won
20 their first Class 3A State football championship by a score of 32-3.
