7 A Resolution welcoming the 2007 Southwest Regional
8 Support Enforcement Association Conference to
9 Oklahoma; thanking the hosts; and directing
10 distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the 2007 Southwest Regional Support Enforcement
12 Association (SWRSEA) Conference, hosted by the Oklahoma Child
13 Support Enforcement Association, the Oklahoma Department of Human
14 Services Child Support Enforcement Division, and the Oklahoma
15 District Attorney's Council, will be held August 19-22, 2007, at the
16 Cox Convention Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and

17 WHEREAS, the 2007 SWRSEA Conference is a gathering of child
18 support professionals from across the Southwest. There will be
19 approximately 500 attorneys, judges, and child support professionals
20 from Texas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Arkansas, and Oklahoma, including
21 members from the Osage, Cherokee, Chickasaw, and Ponca Nations

23 WHEREAS, the SWRSEA Conference is a training opportunity to
24 assist the child support community in better serving the financial

1 needs of children and is dedicated to assuring a reliable source of
2 income for children; and

3 WHEREAS, Oklahoma was chosen as the 2007 host due to the state's
4 Centennial, and the theme of the conference will be "100 Years of
5 Supporting Families".

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
7 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate welcomes the 2007 Southwest
9 Regional Support Enforcement Association Conference to Oklahoma and
10 extends the hospitality of our great state during its Centennial.
