6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution commending the 2006-2007 Millwood boys  
8 athletic teams for winning state championships;  
9 congratulating them for winning the Triple Crown for  
10 the 2006-2007 school year; and directing  
11 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the Millwood Public School District is a pre-  
13 kindergarten through twelfth grade school district with an  
14 enrollment of approximately 1,032 students. The Millwood Public  
15 School District is located within the boundaries of Oklahoma City  
16 and consists of more than ten square miles. The boundaries have  
17 remained the same since 1900. The Millwood Public School District  
18 is an outgrowth of Deep Fork Schools and was founded before 1900, a  
19 block away from Northeast 63rd and what is now Martin Luther King  
20 Boulevard; and

21 WHEREAS, the mission of the Millwood Public School District is  
22 to prepare all students academically and socially for lifelong  
23 learning achievement. The vision of the Millwood Public School  
24 District is a well-defined curriculum, taught by a core of

1 competent, caring teachers with a high degree of active involvement  
2 by students, parents, staff, and community. The philosophy of the  
3 Millwood Public School District is to utilize the best, research-  
4 based teaching and learning strategies to provide effective  
5 instruction in basic skills, to develop the potential of all  
6 students, to develop the aesthetic values of good health,  
7 environment, culture, and country, to nurture a sense of individual  
8 worth and help students understand learning is a process that builds  
9 a foundation of lifelong achievement in a changing world; and

10 WHEREAS, the Millwood High School Falcons football team won a  
11 closely contested game to defeat Vian 21-20 to win the Class 2A  
12 State Football Championship at Broken Arrow Memorial Stadium; and

13 WHEREAS, the Millwood High School Falcons boys basketball team  
14 won a closely contested game to defeat Sequoyah-Tahlequah 55-51 and  
15 win the Class 3A State Boys Basketball Championship at State Fair  
16 Arena; and

17 WHEREAS, the Millwood High School Falcons boys track team were  
18 led by senior Gil Roberts, who won four gold medals and broke  
19 several state records, to win the Class 3A State Boys Track  
20 Championship, thus achieving the coveted "Triple Crown" for the  
21 Millwood High School Falcons for the 2006-2007 school year.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
23 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

1            THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Millwood High School  
2 Falcons boys athletic teams for winning the 2007 Oklahoma Class 2A  
3 State Football Championship, the 2007 Oklahoma Class 3A State  
4 Basketball Championship, and the 2007 Oklahoma Class 3A State Track  
5 Championship.

6            THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Millwood High  
7 School athletic program on achieving the Triple Crown for the 2006-  
8 2007 school year with state championships in football, boys  
9 basketball, and boys track.
