7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution congratulating the Red Oak Lady Eagles  
9 Fastpitch Softball Team; commending their record and  
10 perseverance; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the 2006 fastpitch softball season was the first season  
13 for Class B classification. That year the Red Oak Lady Eagles won  
14 the 2006 Fastpitch Softball Class B State Championship. It was also  
15 the first fastpitch softball championship in the school's history,  
16 although Redoak had played Tulsa Union in 1976 when there was one  
17 classification for all schools. The Oklahoma State Senate passed  
18 Senate Resolution No. 19 in 2007 to congratulate the Red Oak Lady  
19 Eagles; and

20 WHEREAS, the 2007 Class B Fastpitch Softball State Championship  
21 Game was unusual in that it took 72 hours and 11 innings for the Red  
22 Oak Lady Eagles to win their second consecutive state title. Rain  
23 halted the championship contest in the seventh inning when officials  
24 suspended the game because of wet and slippery conditions. It was

1 postponed again three days later. The Lady Eagles finally claimed  
2 victory, edging out Sentinel 8-7 at Hall of Fame Stadium.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
4 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Red Oak Lady  
6 Eagles for winning the 2007 Class B Fastpitch Softball State  
7 Championship, their second consecutive title.

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Red Oak Lady Eagles  
9 Fastpitch Softball Team for their 39-5 season record and for their  
10 perseverance in the championship game.

11 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Superintendent  
12 of Schools Bryan Deatherage and Red Oak Lady Eagles Fastpitch  
13 Softball Coach Shane Mabry.
