7 A Resolution congratulating Randy Tonche for winning
8 the 2007 Oklahoma Class 3A State Wrestling
9 Championship at 215 pounds; praising his athletic
10 prowess; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, Randy Tonche was born June 10, 1988, and started to
12 wrestle at the age of six years. As a freshman he won the Junior
13 High All-State Championship; and

14 WHEREAS, in his senior year at Sallisaw High School, Randy
15 Tonche accumulated a 27-0 record to win the Class 3A State Wrestling
16 Championship at 215 pounds. He won the Oklahoma Coaches Association
17 All-State Maverick Conference Championship with a 4-0 record in the
18 finals; and

19 WHEREAS, Randy Tonche compiled an overall career record of 120
20 wins and 7 losses and a high school record of 100 wins and 7 losses.
21 He was state runner-up as a sophomore and junior at 189 pounds; and

22 WHEREAS, Randy Tonche was a three-sport athlete at Sallisaw High
23 School, in Sallisaw, Oklahoma. He ran track in the spring and
24 played football in the fall. He ran a 49.74 to take the gold medal

1 in the 400 meter dash at the 2007 Class 4A State Track & Field
2 Championship. On the football field he was selected Defensive
3 Player of the Year for Sallisaw and voted District 4A-4 Defensive
4 End/Linebacker of the Year. He is now attending Northeastern
5 Oklahoma A&M College on a football scholarship; and

6 WHEREAS, Randy Tonche has a strong work ethic, a determination
7 never to quit, and a desire to win, which results in successful
8 athletic competition. It is no surprise his favorite movie is
9 "Rocky IV".

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
11 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

12 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates Randy Tonche for
13 winning the 2007 Oklahoma Class 3A State Wrestling Championship at
14 215 pounds.

15 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends Randy Tonche for his
