7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution congratulating the Red Oak Eagles for
9 winning the 2008 Class B State Baseball Championship;
10 commending their perseverance and courage; and
11 directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, when the Red Oak Eagles won the Spring 2008 Class B
13 State Baseball Championship, they won the school's first boy's state
14 championship in any sport. In doing so, they also played in their
15 first state championship game in the school's history; and

16 WHEREAS, during their championship season, the Red Oak Eagles
17 boy's baseball team won the Rock Island Conference Championship,
18 finished third in the University of Arkansas/Fort Smith Tournament,
19 and placed second in the Edmond Tournament; and

20 WHEREAS, the Red Oak Eagles Baseball Team was ranked fourth most
21 of the season. In the state tournament they defeated Cimarron in
22 the first round, Tupelo in the semifinals by coming from behind and
23 winning with a score of 12-11, and Roff in the Championship game,
24 winning 15-5, courtesy of the run rule.

2 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Red Oak Eagles
4 for winning the 2008 Class B State Baseball Championship.

5 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the perseverance and
6 courage of the Red Oak Eagles for their come-from-behind victory in
7 the semifinal game and for not flinching when facing their highly
8 favored opponent in the final game and winning in five innings.
