6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Schultz Family for  
8 their selection as 2008 Special Olympics Oklahoma  
9 Family of the Year; commending their dedication and  
10 commitment; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the Special Olympics Family of the Year Award was  
12 established 39 years ago to recognize outstanding dedication and  
13 family commitment to Special Olympics and to the family's Special  
14 Olympics Athlete. Dale and Carrie Schultz and their son J.C. of  
15 Catoosa, Oklahoma, are extraordinary examples of the care and  
16 commitment of all families and their Special Olympics children; and

17 WHEREAS, J.C. Schultz has competed in the electric wheelchair  
18 races for seven years. His dad, Dale Schultz, has been a volunteer  
19 and chaperone for seven years. Mom Carrie Schultz has been a coach  
20 for the past two years. The Schultz family is active in fundraising  
21 events for their team and ensures that their Special Olympics  
22 athletes have a good time; and

23 WHEREAS, the Schultz Family was honored at the Special Olympics  
24 Oklahoma Summer Games during the May 7, 2008, Opening Ceremonies.

1 Dale, Carrie and J.C. received the 2008 Family of the Year award on  
2 stage at Gallagher Iba Arena at Oklahoma State University in  
3 Stillwater, Oklahoma. The audience of thousands of Special Olympics  
4 athletes, their coaches, families, friends, and volunteers cheered  
5 when the Schultz Family received the 2008 Family of the Year  
6 designation. Dr. Marlene Strathe, Provost, Oklahoma State  
7 University, presented the award to the Schultz Family.

9 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
