

## BILL SUMMARY

MEASURE: SB 1754 Engrossed

SUBJECT: Scrap Metal

### PROVISIONS:

- Section 1. Provides a definition of “exempted seller” to mean any person, firm, corporation or municipal corporation which constructs, operates, or maintains electric distribution and transmission communications facilities, or who produces or otherwise acquires scrap copper in the normal course of business, including manufacturers, distributors, retailers, contractors, holders of farm-use tax permits or junk dealers.
- Section 2. Exempts certain purchases of metal from the ten-day holding period if photographic or video evidence is maintained. Increases to 35 pounds the amount of metal necessary to require a report.
- Section 3. Clarifying language to conform Sections 1 and 2.

Section 12. Clarifying language to conform Sections 1 and 2.
- Section 13. Increases the cap which requires a junk dealer to pay by check from \$25 to \$500.
- Section 14. Repeals 21 O.S. § 1043 relating to the purchase of junk metal from minors.  
Repeals 21 O.S. § 1044 relating to the penalty for violation of 21 O.S. § 1043.
- Section 15. Provides Effective Date.
- Section 16. Provides Emergency.
