Subject: Obscene materials

Provisions:

Section 1: Amends statute as it relates to any commercial film and photographic print processor or commercial computer technician who has knowledge of or observes child pornography, within the scope of such person's professional capacity or employment:

Any person who ~~violates the provisions of~~ files a report as provided in this section, upon conviction, shall be ~~guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by the imposition of a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year, or both such fine and imprisonment~~ immune from civil liability with respect to any report made in good faith
