MEASURE: HB 2623 Full Proposed Committee Substitute 1

AUTHOR: Jordan

SUBJECT: Children

PROVISIONS: Allows a youthful offender who has been sentenced to the Office of Juvenile Affairs to be detained in the county jail while awaiting placement with OJA if the county jail can keep the youthful offender separated by sight and sound from the adult population. Provides that 18 year old youthful offenders may be held in adult population.
