MEASURE: HB 2632 (Introduced Bill)

SUBJECT: Larry Dickerson Education Flexible Benefits Allowance Act

PROVISIONS:

Section 1: Provides the definition of “Dependent” in relation to the Larry Dickerson Education Flexible Benefits Allowance Act.

Section 2: Provides School District employees the option of electing to have a dependent or dependents of the employee covered under the Health insurance plan offered by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board (OSEEGIB), or the self-insured plan offered by the school district. This section also provides further guidelines for election of such an option by the employee.

Section 3: Removes references to inapplicable prior fiscal years. This section also provides that the flexible benefit allowance for support personnel who elect to cover dependents shall not be less than 100% of the premium amount for the HealthChoice (Hi) option plan for an individual plus 75% of the premium amount for the HealthChoice (Hi) option plan for covered spouses and dependents offered by OSEEGIB. These guidelines are also applied to certified personnel who make the same election.

Section 4: Amends current statute to reflect new provisions found in Sections 2 and 3 of this bill.

Section 5: Provides Effective Date

Section 6: Declares an Emergency
