

## BILL SUMMARY

MEASURE: HB 3024 Introduced

SUBJECT: Counties and County Officers

### PROVISIONS:

Section 1. Provides that no election otherwise authorized by this section or any other provisions of the Oklahoma Rural Road Improvement District Act that authorize the imposition of an assessment shall be conducted if the assessment imposed pursuant to Section 902.16 of this title is in excess of three (3) mills.

Section 2. Provides that the assessment may be increased to five (5) mills if the district has no assessment for repayment of debt incurred pursuant to Section 902.12 of this title. Provides that if an assessment is imposed, the proceeds from the assessment shall be used to pay for authorized expenditures of the district and may be accumulated over such period of time as may be required in order to pay for such authorized expenditures as sufficient funds become available on a project by project basis. Provides that an owner of property subject to an assessment imposed may pay the assessment for the current year and as many future years as the owner may elect. The district shall keep accurate records of any prepayments authorized by this subsection. Provides that a rural road improvement district shall be authorized to accept gifts and donations, whether in cash, cash equivalents, or real or personal property. Any funds or property transferred to a rural road improvement district shall be administered as other funds and property of the district.
