MEASURE: HB 3158 Introduced

SUBJECT: ABLE Commission

PROVISIONS:

The measure abolishes the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission and transfers enforcement responsibilities to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. Personnel of the ABLE Commission responsible for enforcement shall be transferred to the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drug Control

Regulatory licensing of alcohol wholesalers is transferred to the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Personnel of the ABLE Commission responsible for regulating alcohol wholesalers shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

The Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Director of the ABLE Commission and the Administrator of the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall serve as transition coordinators and shall establish a transition team to coordinate the orderly transfer of duties, personnel, property, funds, and encumbrances from the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
