

## BILL SUMMARY

MEASURE: HB 3336

AUTHOR: Thompson

SUBJECT: County Jails

### PROVISIONS:

Section 1 amending 22 O.S. § 979a providing that the court shall not waive incarceration costs in their entirety. Provides that any reduction in costs must be applied equally to the fine, costs and costs of incarceration.

Section 2 amending 22 O.S. § 988.12 by deleting language related to the payment of medical expenses by local community sentencing systems.

Section 3 amending 22 O.S. § 991a-2 by deleting language related to the reimbursement of emergency medical care by the Department of Corrections.

Section 4 new law 28 O.S. § 153.4 authorizes collection of \$18 booking fee upon conviction.

Section 5 amending 57 O.S. § 21 providing it is illegal for any person to bring into a jail or penal institution tobacco products, cellular phones or other electronic devices.

Section 6 amending 57 O.S. § 22 provides that it is illegal for jail employee to provide tobacco products to inmate.

Section 7 amending 57 O.S. § 37 provides that the Department of Corrections is responsible for cost of housing inmate in county jail from the date the sentence was ordered by the court.

Section 8 adding new law relating to the reimbursement of health care costs by the Department of Corrections.

Section 9 amending 57 O.S. § 549 by adding language relating to the collection of received funds for inmate savings account.

Section 10 amending 63 O.S. § 1-523 to allow the sheriff to require an inmate to be tested for HIV or AIDS if an employee of the jail comes into contact with the bodily fluids of the inmate.

Section 11 providing an effective date of July 1, 2008 for Section 7.

Section 12 providing for emergency.
