SUBJECT: State Government

PROVISIONS:

Section 1. Allows the Governor to designate enterprise agencies.

Section 2. Provides for annual performance agreements for enterprise agencies.

Section 3. Allows enterprise agencies to maintain control of unused appropriations within their budgets.

Section 4. Provides that an enterprise agency is not limited relating to the number of employees or pay grade assigned to its employees.

Section 5. Allows enterprise agencies to waive any provision of the Central Purchasing Act regarding procurement, fleet management, printing and copying, or maintenance of buildings and grounds .

Section 6. Allows enterprise agencies to waive any provision of the Central Purchasing Act regarding the acquisition and use of information technology.

Section 7. Allows an enterprise agency may temporarily waive or suspend the provisions of any administrative rule if strict compliance with the rule impacts the ability of the enterprise agency to perform its duties in a more cost-efficient manner if certain conditions are met.

Section 8. Requires enterprise agencies to submit a written report to the Governor and the Legislature by December 31 of each year summarizing the activities of the enterprise agency for the preceding fiscal year.

Section 9. Creates an enterprise agency grant fund to provide funding to support innovation by enterprise agencies.
