

## BILL SUMMARY

MEASURE: HB 3393 Proposed Full Committee Substitute

SUBJECT: State Government

### PROVISIONS:

Section 1. Titles the act the "Centennial Savings Act".

Section 2. Requires the Department of Central Services, by the end of the 2009 fiscal year, to demonstrate through the implementation of the Centennial Savings Act, Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) in savings. Requires the Department of Central Services to file quarterly progress reports demonstrating the cost-saving measures being implemented.

Section 3. Creates the five-member Procurement Governance Board.

Section 4. Provides duties of the board.

Section 5. Provides definition of "commodity council" as used with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. Provides definition of "manage contracts" as used with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. Provides definition of "performance metrics" as used with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. Provides definition of "spend data" as used with the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act.

Section 6. Allows the State Purchasing Director to create and use commodity councils; collect and track spend data; implement manage contracts; and create and maintain a centralized electronic inventory of state surplus property that can be shared with agencies.
