

## BILL SUMMARY

MEASURE: SB 1625 Full Proposed Committee Substitute

SUBJECT: Public Safety

### PROVISIONS:

Section 1. Adds individuals, educational institutions and tribal entities to the list of entities that CLEET is allowed to enter into agreements with for professional services, the use of facilities of the Council and supplies, and staff overtime costs incurred as a result of the user's requests to schedule functions after-hours, on weekends, or anytime such requests extend staff beyond its normal capacity, whereby contracting individuals, educational institutions, agencies, and business and tribal entities shall pay a fee to be determined by the Council by rule.

Prohibits the certification as a police or peace officer any person who has been convicted of domestic violence.

Requires every law enforcement agency to notify CLEET of a final order of termination or the resignation while under investigation of a CLEET-certified peace officer. Provides the Council may order the suspension or revocation of the CLEET certification of the peace officer in question. Requires notification of district attorney upon suspension.

Provides that any peace officer employed by a law enforcement agency in this state which has internal discipline policies and procedures on file with CLEET shall be exempt from the disciplinary proceedings and actions provided for in this subsection; provided, however, such exemption shall not apply if the peace officer has been convicted of a felony crime, a crime of moral turpitude, or a crime of domestic violence.

Provides definitions of terms.

Section 2. Requires notification of suspension to the liability insurance company of the law enforcement agency that employed the suspended officer and to the chief elected official of the law enforcement agency's governing body.

Section 3. Provides effective date.
