Summary

ESB 1435 amends the State-Tribal Gaming Act. ESB 1435 modifies the distribution of certain monies received by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission from tribes under the Act. Such monies shall be distributed to the following:

- 1) organization licensees for purses,
- 2) the Oklahoma Breeding Development Fund and
- 3) official horsemen's representatives and breeding organizations.

Analysis

ESB 1435 will not affect the total amount of money received under the State-Tribal Gaming Act it will only affect the Horse Racing Commission's distribution of the funds to private entities. ESB 1435 has no direct fiscal impact on the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or the State of Oklahoma.
