Summary

ESB 1575 relates to the “Oklahoma Abstracting Act”; requires that the abstract plant (the fully indexed records showing all instruments of record affecting lands within a county) which are filed or recorded shall be “currently available for reproduction” in the offices of the county clerk and the court clerk in the county for which an abstract plant is maintained.

Analysis

In its present form, this measure has no impact on state revenue or expenditures.

The Oklahoma Abstractors Board advises that there would be no costs to the counties under the provisions of the measure, provided that the copying fee charged for archived documents is sufficient to cover county clerks’ costs.
