13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
14 entire bill and insert

15 "An Act relating to agriculture; prohibiting wrongful
16 injury or removal of certain cervidae; providing
17 penalty; specifying damages; providing for
18 codification; and declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-511 of Title 2, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. No person shall wrongfully injure any cervidae upon the
2 premises of a farmed cervidae facility or wrongfully remove any
3 cervidae from the premises of a farmed cervidae facility.

4 B. Any violation of the provision of subsection A of this
5 section shall be deemed a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall
6 be punishable by a fine not less than Five Thousand Dollars
7 (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a
8 period not exceeding two (2) years, or both such fine and
9 imprisonment. In addition, any person violating the provisions of
10 subsection A of this section shall be liable for damages of not less
11 than three times nor more than ten times such a sum as would
12 compensate for the actual detriment.

13 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
