15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
16 entire bill and insert

17 "An Act relating to crimes and punishments;
18 prohibiting certain activities in relation to DNA of
19 newborn child; providing for codification; and
20 declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1175 of Title 21, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A laboratory, medical facility, hospital or birthing place is
2 prohibited from the unauthorized storage, transferring, use or
3 databasing of DNA from any newborn child without express parental
4 consent.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
