13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

15 "An Act relating to public health and safety;
16 amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 4020, as amended by
17 Section 2, Chapter 379, O.S.L. 2004 (63 O.S. Supp.
18 2009, Section 4020), which relates to the Oklahoma
19 Vessel and Motor Registration Act; modifying
20 procedures for renewal notifications; authorizing
21 certain fee amount; providing for receipt of renewal
22 notifications by members of the armed forces and
23 components of armed forces and related parties;
24 authorizing certain methods for notification;
modifying required content of notifications;
imposing duty on the Oklahoma Tax Commission with
respect to procedures for annual notifications; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 4020, as
2 amended by Section 2, Chapter 379, O.S.L. 2004 (63 O.S. Supp. 2009,
3 Section 4020), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 4020. ~~Beginning January 1, 1990, the~~ The Oklahoma Tax
5 Commission shall notify through the mail, or via electronic mail,
6 all persons who have not opted out of the notification system within
7 the state who have previous vessel or motor registrations on record
8 of the period for registration that are due to be registered in July
9 of that year. ~~Such~~ Persons choosing to receive such annual
10 notification through the mail shall be assessed an annual fee of
11 fifty cents (\$0.50), notwithstanding the provisions of Section
12 1114.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which shall be used by
13 the Tax Commission for printing and mailing of renewal
14 notifications. Members of the armed forces of the United States,
15 the Reserve Corps of the armed forces of the United States, and the
16 Oklahoma National Guard and their spouses eligible for the military
17 registration fee, as provided in Section 4021 of this title, shall
18 receive a renewal notification without payment of such fee. The
19 printed notice shall contain all necessary information for such
20 registration including a breakdown of all charges to be paid by the
21 owner. The breakdown of the charges to be paid by the owner shall
22 include the charges an owner would pay to register the vessel or
23 motor for a one-year period and the charges an owner would pay to
24 register the vessel or motor for a three-year period. Use of a

1 postcard or electronic mail-type renewal notice is specifically
2 permitted. The content and form of the notice shall also contain
3 instructions as to the procedure for renewal upon presentation to a
4 motor license agent or by return mail to the Tax Commission's state
5 office. ~~On the back of such registration notice form there shall be~~
6 ~~an explanation of the apportionment of all fees and penalties~~
7 ~~collected and their disposition.~~ Such explanation shall include
8 ~~information as to all charges and fees included in the total fee or~~
9 ~~incident to the registration of a vessel or motor.~~ If the owner
10 chooses the option of receiving these services through the mail,
11 either from the Commission or a motor license agent, he shall be
12 instructed to pay the final total listed for the period of
13 registration chosen by the owner. The Tax Commission shall provide
14 information on its public website instructing persons on the
15 procedure for obtaining an annual notification via electronic mail,
16 free of charge, outlining all charges and fees associated with the
17 registration of vessels and motors, as well as an explanation of the
18 apportionment of vessel and motor registration fees and penalties.
19 The cost of mailing shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) for titles or other
20 forms or devices required by the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor
21 Registration Act. Provided, that the Tax Commission may adjust any
22 mailing costs as deemed appropriate to allow for increased or
23 additional fees charged by the United States Postal Service.

1 Failure by any applicant to receive notification of renewal as
2 provided by this section shall not excuse the applicant from
3 properly obtaining any registration at the proper time by presenting
4 proof of ownership to the Tax Commission's state office or to a
5 motor license agent.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
