14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
15 entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to schools; amending Section 3,
17 Chapter 453, O.S.L. 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009,
18 Section 1210.453), which relates to the Oklahoma
19 School for the Visual and Performing Arts;
20 prohibiting the Oklahoma School for the Visual and
21 Performing Arts from offering campus summer arts
22 camp programs for certain students during certain
23 time period; defining certain phrase; and limiting
24 enforcement of law under certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 453, O.S.L.
2 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1210.453), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1210.453 A. The board of trustees of the Oklahoma
5 School for the Visual and Performing Arts shall have the authority
6 to adopt rules necessary to comply with the provisions of ~~this act~~
7 Sections 1210.451 through 1210.453 of this title and any other
8 requirements placed upon the board of trustees by law.

9 B. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that the board
10 of trustees of the Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing
11 Arts establish a hiring policy for the Oklahoma School for the
12 Visual and Performing Arts which provides that applicants for
13 employment positions with the school who are residents of this state
14 shall be given priority for employment over applicants who are not
15 residents of this state if all other qualifications are equal.

16 C. The Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing Arts shall
17 not offer any campus summer arts camp programs for students in
18 grades nine through twelve during the period between the end of the
19 regular spring semester of the school and the beginning of the
20 regular fall semester of the school. For purposes of this section,
21 "campus summer arts camp programs" means programs in which students
22 are residentially housed as a group for two (2) weeks or less by the
23 school. The provisions of this subsection shall not be enforced if
24 either the Oklahoma Arts Institute, a nonprofit organization which

1 is funded in part by private and state funds and utilizes the Quartz
2 Mountain Arts and Conference Center and Nature Park for a fine arts
3 institute and continuing education programs, or the Oklahoma School
4 for the Visual and Performing Arts is not operating or ceases to
5 exist."
