~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.7 of Title 11, unless
 3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and
 5 except for persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of
 6 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, effective July 1, 2010, any
 7 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Firefighters
 8 Pension and Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
 9 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
 10 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

11 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
 12 pursuant to repealed Section 49-136 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
 13 Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be used to offset the increase
 14 in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

15 C. Effective July 1, 2010, any persons receiving benefits
 16 pursuant to Section 49-101 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes
 17 shall each receive a benefit equal to _____
 18 for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty (30) years of
 19 service.

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50-136.9 of Title 11, unless
 22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
 24 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension

1 and Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to receive
2 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
3 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

4 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
5 pursuant to repealed Section 50-120 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
6 Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be offset by the increase in
7 benefits, if any, provided by this section.

8 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104K of Title 20, unless there
10 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 Any person who is receiving benefits from The Uniform Retirement
12 System for Justices and Judges as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
13 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
14 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

15 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-305.12 of Title 47, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
19 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
20 Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to receive
21 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
22 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

23 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
24 pursuant to subsection B, C or D of Section 2-305 of Title 47 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes, after June 30, 2010, shall be offset by the
2 increase in benefits, if any, provided by this section.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.22 of Title 70, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 A. Any person who is receiving benefits from the Teachers'
7 Retirement System of Oklahoma as of June 30, 2009, other than those
8 benefits specified in subsection B of this section, who continues to
9 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
10 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

11 B. Any person receiving benefits pursuant to subsection (3) of
12 Section 17-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes whose benefits
13 commenced prior to July 1, 2009, and who continues to receive
14 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
15 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

16 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.11 of Title 74, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Any person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public
20 Employees Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
21 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
22 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July
23 2010.

24 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.
