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14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and  
entire bill and insert  
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16 "An Act relating to public health and safety;  
17 directing the State Department of Health to  
18 establish and make available on its website a  
19 certain registry; specifying information to be  
20 included in certain registry; providing certain  
21 deadline; requiring certain registry before  
22 employment; prohibiting the hiring or employment of  
23 certain persons; directing the State Board of Health  
24 to promulgate certain rules; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1981 of Title 63, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The State Department of Health shall establish and make  
5 available to the public on its website a registry for persons who  
6 are employed by or who contract with a home care agency to provide  
7 home care services.

8 B. The information provided on the registry shall include, but  
9 shall not be limited to:

10 1. The individual's full name;

11 2. Information necessary to identify each individual;

12 3. The date the individual's name was placed in the registry;

13 and

14 4. Information on the individual provided in a criminal history  
15 records search conducted by the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
16 Investigation.

17 C. Individuals who are employed by or who contract with a home  
18 care agency to provide home care services prior to January 1, 2011,  
19 shall be required to register with the Department before January 1,  
20 2011. Individuals hired by or contracted with a home care agency to  
21 provide home care services on or after January 1, 2011, shall be  
22 required to register with the Department before accepting such  
23 employment or contract with the home care agency.

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1 D. Beginning on January 1, 2011, home care agencies shall be  
2 prohibited from hiring, contracting with, or continuing to employ or  
3 contract with a person who provides home care services who has not  
4 registered with the State Department of Health.

5 E. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules as  
6 necessary to implement the registry, which may include, but shall  
7 not be limited to, fees for registry and penalties for  
8 noncompliance.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010."
