14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to children; permitting the Office
17 of Juvenile Affairs to sell certain real estate;
18 directing the deposit of certain monies; providing
for the utilization of certain monies; providing for
19 codification; providing an effective date; and
20 declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-612 of Title 10A, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. The Office of Juvenile Affairs may sell real estate owned by
2 the State of Oklahoma or the Office of Juvenile Affairs that is
3 surplus to its use under the jurisdiction of the Office of Juvenile
4 Affairs located within LeFlore County and situated within Talihina.

5 B. All monies received from the sale of the property, except
6 those monies necessary to pay the expenses incurred pursuant to the
7 sale, shall be deposited in the Office of Juvenile Affairs Revolving
8 Fund 200 ("200 Fund"). Revenue derived from such real estate sale
9 deposited to the fund shall be utilized for the benefit of the
10 Office of Juvenile Affairs as necessary to perform the duties
11 imposed upon the Office of Juvenile Affairs by law. Such real
12 estate sale shall not be subject to the provisions of Section 456.7
13 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
