20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132A of Title 47, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. In any online system administered by the Oklahoma Tax
2 Commission dealing with the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
3 Registration Act the Tax Commission shall include a step where the
4 individual must select between any motor license agent in the state
5 and the Tax Commission to process any registration renewal or other
6 request.

7 B. Motor license agents shall receive all fees provided by
8 statute for registration renewals or other requests processed by the
9 motor license agent through any online system administered by the
10 Tax Commission.

11 C. The selection step required pursuant to subsection A of this
12 section shall be installed and operational no later than July 1,
13 2010.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
