22 "Such monitoring by the victim shall be limited to the ability of
23 the victim to make computer or cellular inquiries to determine if
24 the defendant is within a specified distance of locations, excluding

1 the residence or workplace of the defendant, or to receive a
2 computer- or a cellular-generated signal if the defendant comes
3 within a specified distance of the victim. The court shall conduct
4 an annual review of the monitoring order to determine if such order
5 to monitor the location of the defendant is still necessary."
